

Section 1 – Description of Public Hearing Exhibits and Materials

Copies of the exhibits/materials marked with an asterisk are included in this public hearing record. Other materials are on file at the WisDOT Southeast Region office.

Display Boards and Roll Plots (on easels and tables)

- **Alternatives Still Under Consideration Maps*** – Shows each alternative’s alignment over an aerial photograph and highlights resources throughout the project corridor.
- **Typical Finished Sections*** - Shows sections of the proposed West Waukesha Bypass 4-lane roadway.
- **Environmental Impact Maps and Matrix*** – Shows the environmental impacts of each of the remaining alternatives.
- **Roadway Level of Service*** – Shows the effectiveness of the current roadway and remaining alternatives by giving a grade to each segment and intersection in the project corridor.
- **2035 Average Weekday Traffic Volumes*** – Shows traffic volumes for each of the remaining alternatives.
- **Groundwater Flow Maps*** – Shows groundwater flow patterns and locations where groundwater discharges at the surface in and around the project area.

- **Noise Receptor Location Maps*** – Shows impacted noise receptors and possible noise barrier locations.
- **Soil Boring Locations*** – Shows soil boring locations and soil profiles.
