**Public hearing scheduled
for West Waukesha Bypass
(County TT from Rolling Ridge Drive to WIS 59)
Waukesha County**

Mark your calendar
Waukesha County will hold a public hearing on the location, design and environmental aspects of proposed improvements on County TT from Rolling Ridge Drive to WIS 59 known as the West Waukesha Bypass in Waukesha County.

The public hearing will be held on Tuesday, November 13, 2012 at the Waukesha North High School Auditorium, 2222 Michigan Avenue, Waukesha. The hearing will be conducted from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. with formal testimony beginning at 5 p.m. Interested persons are urged to attend to review displays and other hearing materials, ask questions and provide testimony. Project staff will be available to explain the proposed improvements and answer questions. Information on how to present oral and written testimony will be provided at the public hearing.

The public hearing facility is wheelchair accessible. Hearing impaired persons needing assistance should contact the Wisconsin Telecommunications Relay System (dial 711). To allow for arranging assistance, please call no later than three working days prior to the public hearing.

Proposed Improvements
Proposed improvements in the County TT corridor include the following:

- Widen County TT from two to four lanes between Rolling Ridge Drive and Sunset Drive
- Build a 4-lane roadway connection between Sunset Drive and WIS 59 on one of three potential routes
 - o Widen existing Sunset Drive to four lanes between County TT and County X and using County X to reach WIS 59.
 - o Build a new four-lane roadway on new alignment between Sunset Drive and WIS 59. Two potential routes referred to as the Pebble Creek West and Pebble Creek Far West Alternatives are under consideration.
- Construct a new bridge over Pebble Creek, Wisconsin & Southern Railroad and the Glacial Drumlin State Trail
- Construct a multi-use trail adjacent to the widened roadway between Summit Avenue and Sunset Drive.
- Add a new signal or roundabout at the County TT/Madison Street intersection.

Additional information
A Draft Environmental Impact Statement (Draft EIS) that discusses the need for the proposed improvements, alternatives considered, environmental effects, has been prepared and filed according to the State and National Environmental Policy Acts. The Draft EIS will be available for viewing at the public hearing and is available for inspection and copying at the repositories listed below and on the project website:

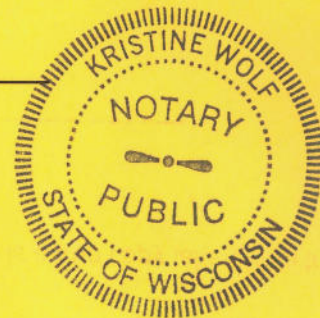
